

2013-14 District Training at OSU

Note: Districts with several schools may be interested in training a District Trainer to build literacy capacity in their district. Candidates may train at either the primary or intermediate level, depending on their background and qualifications.

Qualifications for a District Trainer

1. Trained as a Reading Recovery teacher (primary only)
2. Successful completion of literacy coach training (primary or intermediate)
3. Master's degree

Responsibilities of a District Trainer

1. Successfully complete district-level training
 - Participate in Literacy Coach Training Sessions at OSU (2 weeks)
 - Participate in Literacy Coach Online Training Sessions (10 sessions)
 - Participate in Ongoing Literacy Coach Professional Development at OSU (4 days in fall; 4 days in spring)
 - Participate in site visits with university trainer at district site (Two 2-day site visits)
 - Completion of assigned readings and reflections
 - Analysis of assigned videotaped lessons/Coaching and Teaching
 - Completion of Case Study Research Project
 - Presentation of professional development session
2. Teach children a minimum of 20 hours/year
3. Train building level literacy coaches from schools in their district (literacy coaches in training must be released for training during the school day)
4. Coach literacy coaches in-training a minimum of 3 1/2 days per week
5. Conduct team-planning sessions for schools interested in becoming Literacy Collaborative schools
6. Submit a district-level research report on the implementation of Literacy Collaborative in the district

District Training Costs

1. Instructional/Training Fee (PD, two 2-day site visits with travel expenses paid by the district): \$25,000 for an affiliated school; \$35,000 for a non-affiliated school
2. Tuition (3 graduate credit hours): approximately \$2200
3. Materials Fee: \$500 (materials purchased by district as needed)
4. LC Site Affiliation Fee: \$260/year

Implementation Costs after completion of District Training

1. Ongoing Professional Development (8 days per year) at OSU
 - a. 6 days/year at OSU @ \$170/day (\$1020 total) for year 2 and beyond
 - b. 2 days guided planning/year at OSU (no registration fee)
2. LC Site Affiliation Fee: \$260/year for the district trainer and each literacy coach
3. Research Fee (district trainers do not pay a research fee):
 - a. \$750/literacy coach in the training year (Year 1)
 - b. \$200/literacy coach in Year 2 and beyond
4. Site visits:
 - a. Year 2: Two 2-day site visits at \$750/day (travel expenses paid by the district)
 - b. Year 4 and beyond: One 2-day site visit required every two years at \$750/day (travel expenses paid by the district)
