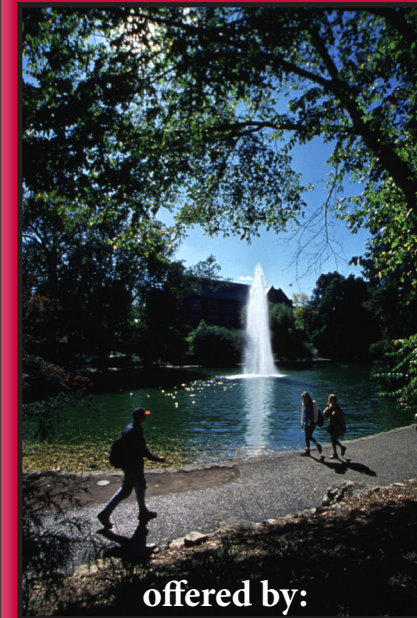

Prin cipals' Academy is designed for administrators, superintendents, and curriculum leaders in Literacy Collaborative schools or those considering joining the Literacy Collaborative network.

Participants will study the key role of the administrators with a strong emphasis on school culture. Identify phases of teacher growth and discuss characteristics of quality teaching. Study how children learn to read and write, ways to support the literacy coach, and how to increase student achievement.

Participants will also learn to use evaluation tools that help monitor progress in teaching and learning as they support implementation of Literacy Collaborative.
