

## **District Training at OSU**

**Note:** Districts with several schools may be interested in training a District Trainer to build early literacy capacity in their district. District Trainers may train Literacy Coordinators at either the Primary or the Intermediate level for their district.

### **Qualifications for a District Trainer**

1. Trained as a Reading Recovery teacher (primary only)
2. Successful completion of literacy coordinator training (primary or intermediate)
3. Master's degree

### **Responsibilities of a District Trainer**

1. Successfully complete district-level training (primary or intermediate)
2. Teach children a minimum of 20 hours/year
3. Train building level literacy coordinators from schools in their district (literacy coordinators in training must be released for training during the school day)
4. Coach literacy coordinators in-training a minimum of 3 1/2 days per week
5. Conduct team-planning sessions for schools interested in becoming Literacy Collaborative schools
6. Submit a district-level research report on the implementation of Literacy Collaborative in the district

### **Cost of Training and Implementation**

1. Instructional/Training Fee
  - a. For a beginning school: \$40,000 (includes tuition for 3 graduate credit hours)
  - b. For a continuing school: \$24,310 (includes tuition for 3 graduate credit hours)
2. Materials Fee: \$500
3. Ongoing Professional Development (8 days per year) at OSU
  - 6 days/year at OSU @ \$160/day
  - 2 days guided planning/year at OSU (no registration fee)
4. School Network Affiliation Fee: \$260 for each Literacy Coordinator in year 1 (covers affiliation fee) and \$460 for each Literacy Coordinator in year 2 and beyond (covers affiliation and research fee); \$260 for the district trainer each year
5. Research Fee: District Trainers do not pay a research fee
6. Site visits:
  - Training Year: Two 2-day site visits (travel expenses paid by the district)
  - Year 2: Two 2-day site visits at \$750/day (travel expenses paid by the district)
  - Year 4 and beyond: One 2-day site visit required every two years at \$750/day (travel expenses paid by the district)
7. National Research & Affiliation Fee: \$750 for each LC in their training year
